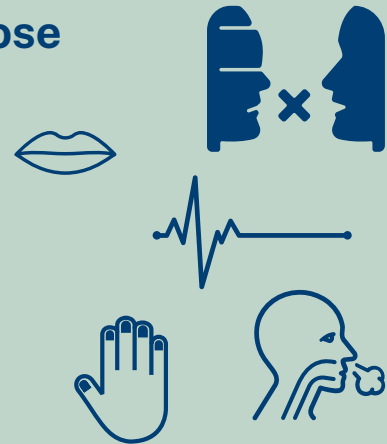


# IDENTIFYING AND RESPONDING TO AN OPIOID OVERDOSE

## 01 Recognizing signs of an opioid overdose

- Cannot be awakened or unable to speak
- Skin is extremely pale, cold, or clammy
- Breathing or heartbeat slows or stops
- Fingernails or lips have a blue or purple color
- Vomiting or making choking/gurgling sounds
- Body goes limp



IF YOU SUSPECT AN OVERDOSE, **CALL 911 IMMEDIATELY**

## 02 Responding to an opioid overdose

**S**timulate - speak loudly, rub sternum, pinch skin

**A**irway - check airway, tilt head and lift chin to open airway

**V**entilate - pinch nose and give 1 breath every 5 seconds

**E**valuate - are they breathing? If not, proceed to medicate

**M**edication - inject nasal spray into nose or by needle into muscle

**E**valuate and support - continue giving breaths. If no change within 3-5 minutes, give another dose of naloxone

Harnett County's rate of overdose deaths has increased tenfold since 2000. In 2021, there were 71 overdose-related deaths in Harnett County.
