



IRS Certified Volunteers Providing

FREE TAX PREPARATION

Locally trained and IRS certified volunteers through the Harnett County Retired Senior Volunteer Program, RSVP, will provide free individual federal and state income tax preparation and electronic filing starting January 31, 2017 through April 13, 2017.

Tax preparation is available at the **Coats Senior Center on Tuesday** mornings and at the **Erwin Library on Thursday** mornings by appointment.

Taxpayer age and income limits do not apply to most of the returns that can be prepared.

Proof of Social Security numbers for everyone on the return (including children) must be provided as well as all income documents (W-2s, 1099s, Social Security statements, etc.) and any deductions (home mortgage interest, state and property taxes paid, education or child care expenses, etc.) Proof of health insurance coverage is a must (usually a Form 1095 A, B or C, or your Social Security statement for taxpayers over 65)

If we did not prepare your return last year, please bring a copy of last year's return.
