Early Educator Certification (EEC) is now law!

How will you meet recertification requirements?

This law requires teaching staff, administrators and family child care providers working in or operating a licensed facility regulated by the NC Division of Child Development to be certified by the NC Institute for Child Development Professionals (Intitute) as of July 1, 2012. Staff newly hired must be certified within 60 days of hire. **TRAINING REQUIREMENTS EXIST FOR RECERTIFICATION.** The number of CEUs required is dependent on your level of certification.
