



SOLID WASTE DIVISION

The Harnett County Solid Waste Division in cooperation with the Harnett County Cooperative Extension, and the NCDA&CS Pesticide Disposal Assistance Program will sponsor a one day Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event on November 1, 2014 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., at the Harnett County Agricultural Extension Office, 126 Alexander Drive, Lillington, NC 27546.

In addition to household hazardous waste, agricultural and household pesticides & herbicides will also be collected. The following items will be accepted: latex paint, oil-based paint, aerosols, solvents, degreasers, alkalines (e.g. household cleaners, drain cleaners), acids, oxidizers (such as pool chemicals), rechargeable batteries, lead acid batteries, fluorescent light tubes, and thermostats. No propane cylinders, oil, antifreeze, fuels or pharmaceuticals will be accepted during this collection event. Pharmaceuticals can be dropped off anytime during business hours at a collection box located just inside the Harnett County Sheriff's Office.

Latex paint will be accepted at the event, but latex paint is non-hazardous and can be disposed of in normal trash as long as it is hardened. Cat litter can be used to harden latex paint.
