

## **The U.S. Census Bureau is hiring in Harnett County**

The Census Bureau is hiring for the following positions in Harnett County:

- Census Takers
- Crew Leaders
- Crew Leader Assistants
- Recruiting Assistants
- Census Clerks

The greatest staffing need is for census takers. Census takers work in their communities locating households, explaining the purpose of the census, conducting personal interviews with respondents who failed to return their 2010 Census questionnaire, and recording their responses on paper forms. In most cases, a valid driver's license and use of a vehicle are required to work as a census taker.

You may qualify if:

- You are a U.S. citizen or a legal permanent resident, or non-citizen with an appropriate work visa
- You are at least 18 years old
- You have a valid Social Security number
- You take a 30 minute written test of basic clerical skills, reading skills, number skills, interpreting information and evaluating alternatives and organizational skills
- You pass a background check
- You commit to four days of paid training

These jobs are temporary, most lasting up to 8 weeks. Work schedules are flexible, typically from 20 to 40 hours a week. These positions require interviewing the public, so you must be available to work when people are usually at home, such as in the evening and on weekends. Census taker pay rate for Harnett County is \$13.50 per hour and 55 cents per mile reimbursement for authorized mileage.
