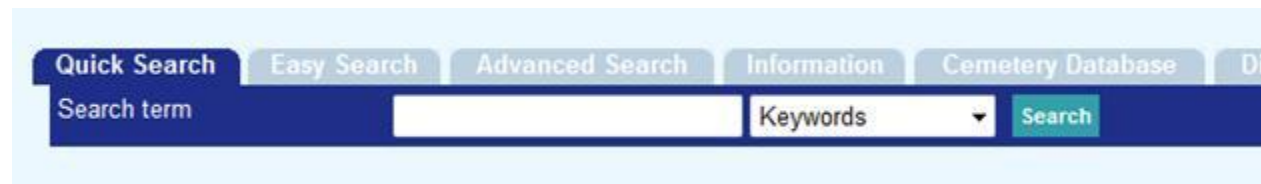

- *Information* tab to quickly find a list of the DVDs, New Book list and more.
- *Cemetery Database* to search for a gravesite in Harnett County.
- *Digital Database* to view historical photos.
- *Community Information* to find local information.

Use your library card and pin to access **User Activities** in the Library Catalog such as:

- Reserve items (you can select your pick-up locations)
- View items that you have on loan and the due dates.
- Renew items that you have on loan.
- Alerting Services allows you to request an email sent to you letting you know when the library has something that meets your search criteria. You do not need to keep checking when we get a new title by your favorite author; we will send you an email.
- Change your pin code, phone number or email address.
