5. The decision of the judges shall be final.
6. The first prize for each category will be \$50.00; second prize \$20.05; third prize \$18.55. There will be a grand prize of \$150.00 for the beard deemed by the Judges as "Best in Show".
- 7 The deadline for entry in the beard-growing contest is October 10, 2005.
8. You will be informed of further details regarding your entry by October 24, 2005.
