Toddler Time typically lasts about 30 minutes and includes simple stories, flannel boards, fingerplays, puppets, and songs as well as other activities with a toddler's short attention span and need for movement in mind.

Preschool storytimes are created especially for children 3-5 years of age. They typically last approximately 45 minutes and include stories, flannel boards, fingerplays, puppets, and songs as well as other developmentally appropriate activities. Occasionally a craft activity will be provided at the end of the program as well as a snack treat during holidays and other special events.

Saturday Morning Family Time

The purpose of offering children's programs on Saturday mornings is to provide an organized library activity for children who are unable to attend storytime during the week. All children are encouraged to attend Saturday morning storytime, however, activities are geared to appeal to older preschool, primary, and elementary aged children.
