DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

- ___ Campers can be dropped off each day for camp beginning at 7:30 AM
- ___ All campers must be picked up no later than 6:00 PM each evening
- ___ There will only be ONE warning if a child is picked up later than 6 PM. After this warning, the late fee is \$1 per minute per child after 6 PM. This fee will need to be paid at the time of pickup.
- ___ A child will not be permitted to return to camp until the late pickup fee is paid
- ___ If you are consistently late for pickup, your child will be dropped from the program

_____ No refunds will be issued once camps have begun. Weekly transfers can possibly be accommodated if space is available.

_____ All requests for transfers must be made in writing to Drew Bryant seven (7) days before the first day of the affected day of camp. Email requests can be made at wbryant@harnett.org

MEDICAL DISCLAIMER

_____ There is no medical personnel on staff at the Boone Trail Community Center. However, all camp staff is CPR and First Aid certified. In the event of a minor injury (cut, scrape, bruise, etc.), our staff will apply ointment, band aids, or an ice pack. If a child complains of feeling ill, the parent/guardian or emergency contact (if parent/guardian cannot be reached) will be contacted and asked to pick up their child as soon as possible from camp. In the event of a severe injury or medical emergency, a staff member will call 911 immediately and the parent/guardian, or emergency contact, will be notified immediately.

DISCIPLINARY POLICY

_____ Disciplinary problems will be handled first by a conversation with the camper. If the issue continues, a parent conference will be requested. Suspension from camp is possible with ongoing issues. Immediate suspension may occur based on the severity of the offense (see parent handbook for further details).

_____ If the staff finds that a camper cannot function safely within the group due to a behavioral or medical problem, we will ask that the camper be withdrawn from the program.

If food items require refrigeration, it is parent's responsibility to place ice packs in the lunch box to keep it cold.

_____ For the safety of all campers, tennis shoes and socks are required to be worn by campers at all times. Campers should wear clothing that is cool and comfortable. They should wear clothes that parents do not mind getting soiled by dirt, grass, paint, glue, water, etc.
