Pumpkin Pie



Ingredients:

- 1 (15 ounce) of pumpkin puree
- 1 (14-ounce) can sweetened condensed milk
- 2 Large Eggs
- 1 tablespoon pumpkin pie spice
- 2 blind back 9-inch pie shells, or 1 unbaked 9-inch pie shell
- Arrange an oven rack in lowest position and heat over 425 F.
- Place the pumpkin puree, sweetened condensed milk, eggs, and pumpkin pie spice in a large bowl and whisk until combined
- If making 2 (9 inch) pies: Divide the filling 2 blind baked 9- inch pie shells. Bake for 15 minutes. Reduce temperature to 350 F and bake until a knife inserted in the center comes out clean, 15 to 20 minutes more. Let cool on a wire rack for 2 hours. Serve immediately or refrigerate until ready to serve.
