- Important recovery tools (chainsaw, drills, etc.)
- Duct tape
- Tarps
- Paper cups, plates, and utensils
- Flashlights with extra batteries
- Matches in a waterproof container
- · Napkins and paper towels
- Aluminum foil

- Manual can opener
- Non-perishable and canned foods

# **SPECIAL NEEDS ITEMS**

- Infant needs: stocked diaper bag, formula, bottles, baby food, diapers, rash cream, medicines, extra clothes

# IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS

(keep these documents in a waterproof, portable container)

- Will, insurance policies, contracts, deeds
- Passports, social security cards, birth certificates
- Bank account numbers
- Important telephone numbers
- Family records (birth, marriage, and death certificates)
- Proof of occupancy
- Pictures of your home pre-storm (for insurance purposes)
- Other important papers and photos albums
- Identification to be carried by each child in case your family members become separated
