Sealed bids for the construction of the Harnett County Jail Demolition will be received at the Harnett County Resource Center and Library, 455 McKinney Parkway, Lillington, N.C., until 2:00 pm local time on Thursday, October 7, 2021, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read via virtual call due to Covid-19 restrictions for in person attendance.

The Project consists of constructing the following major items:

- Demolition of the existing Jail Facility at the Harnett County Emergency Services Center

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum basis, as indicated in the Bid Form.

Complete Bidding Documents may be obtained at the Issuing Office of the Engineer upon payment of a non-refundable deposit of \$75.00 for each set. With request for Bidding Documents supply the following information: Company name, contact person, street address, and phone and fax numbers for Bidding office; N. C. contractor's license with limitation and classification; indicate if the firm will be a Bidder, Supplier or Sub-Contractor.

Bidders will be required to show evidence that they are licensed to perform the work in the Bidding Documents in conformity North Carolina General Statute, Chapter 87 and the Instructions to Bidders. Bid Security in the amount of five percent of the Bid must accompany each Bid and shall be subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bidders shall be required to submit with their Bids affidavits of "Good Faith Efforts" in the recruitment of Minority Businesses.
