OLD HAMILTON ROAD WATER EXTENSION

Sealed bids for the project entitled **Old Hamilton Road Water Extension** will be received by **Harnett Regional Water** until **2:00 PM. local time on Thursday, September 24, 2026**, in the **Harnett Regional Water** headquarters, located at **700 McKinney Parkway, Lillington, North Carolina 27546**. At said place and time, all Bids that have been duly received, will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of the extension of approximately 13,600 linear feet of 8-inch diameter water main with related appurtenances to be constructed along the western side of Old Hamilton Road (SR-1776) within the portion of the roadway covered by the blanket easement/encroachment agreement that HRW has with NCDOT, the northern Side of Antioch Church Road (SR-1735) and the western side of Lucas Road (SR-1721), extending from NC-82.

Bidder qualifications, as described in Article 3 of the Instructions to Bidders, are required to be submitted with the Bid. Bidders are encouraged to inquire about minimum qualifications before purchasing Bidding Documents.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at **2:00 PM. local time on Thursday, September 17, 2026**, in the **Harnett Regional Water** headquarters, located at **700 McKinney Parkway, Lillington, North Carolina 27546**. Interested parties should attend this meeting to receive bidding information.

Neither the Owner nor the Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including any Addenda, obtained from any source other than the Engineer and their representative plan provider, QuestCDN. Each Bidder shall be responsible for the review of all addenda for the project and shall acknowledge the addenda on the bid form.

Bidders must comply with the requirements of the State of North Carolina and be appropriately licensed as a Contractor as provided in General Statutes Chapter 87. The Bidder is required to print their Contractor's License number clearly on the outside of the Bid envelope.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a cash deposit or certified check drawn on a bank or trust company insured by the FDIC or a Bid Bond prepared on the form of Bid Bond contained in the Bidding Documents or a Surety Company's standard form and properly executed by a corporate surety licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bonds. The amount of the bid bond shall be equal to **five (5) percent** of the total of the bid. The bid deposit shall be retained by the Owner if the successful bidder fails to execute the contract or fails to provide the required bonds, as stated above, within ten (10) days after the proper notice of award of the contract.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive informalities, or to reject non-conforming, non-responsive, or conditional bids. The Owner reserves the right to award a contract to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder or bidders, taking into consideration quality, performance and time.

Contractors submitting a Bid on this project must solicit bids from minority subcontractors and provide documentation of any outreach efforts as required by the Special Conditions Packages.

Bidders must comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 as amended, which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex or national origin. Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis-Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, the Contract Work Hours Standard Act, and 40 CFR 33.1016, and 40 CFR 60-4.
