As part of Harnett County's continuing emergency preparedness effort, we continue to make available free potassium iodide tablets (KI) to county residents who live, work and/or attend schools within a 10-mile radius of Emergency Planning Zone (EPZ) of the Harris Nuclear Power Plant.

KI should be kept in a safe, accessible location and should only be taken when instructed by public health authorities. If you are unable to pick-up at this site, please call the Health Department 910-893-7550 regarding a pick-up appointment.

Anyone who is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or is a close contact and currently under quarantine restrictions, should contact the Health Department to arrange pick up of KI tablets.
