
Outbreaks & Clusters Reported the Week of October 9, 2020





Outbreaks: In a congregate living setting, a COVID-19 outbreak is defined as two or more laboratory-confirmed cases. Facilities with less than 10 residents are not included to protect patient confidentiality.

Clusters: A COVID-19 cluster is defined as a minimum of five laboratory-confirmed cases in close proximity.

Data are preliminary, and these numbers and facilities are subject to change as more information is obtained during outbreak investigations.
