\_\_\_\_ Identify the appropriate classification. WS-III-BW, WS-IV-CA, WS-IV-PA

## Lot Dimensions

\_\_\_\_ Actual dimensions and acreage of the lot to be built upon and the location of any right of ways that may affect development on the lot.

### **Built Upon Area**

- \_\_\_\_ The accurate location and use of all existing and proposed buildings and other structures, and for non-residential developments the location and size, in square feet, of all built-upon areas including parking and loading facilities.
- \_\_\_\_ The percent of the project that will be covered with an impervious surface.
- \_\_\_\_ The area, in acres, to be left natural.

### **Dwelling Units**

The total number of dwelling units proposed on the lot or tract.

### **Streams/Rivers**

\_ The accurate location of all perennial streams and natural drainage areas on the property.

## **Adjacent Property Owners**

#### Buffers

\_ The location of all required buffer areas.

#### **Private Water and Sewer Systems**
