NATIONAL WOMEN'S HEALTH WEEK May 8 - 14, 2022

#### National Women's Health Week is May 8-14!

The Health Department encourages women of all ages to reflect on their health journey and take steps towards improving their health. In recognition of NWHW, the Health Department will be providing resource bags for women, teens and girls on various health topics.

The "Mosquito Dunks" is a type of insecticide used to control mosquitoes outdoors around your home. They work by killing mosquito larvae before they can grow into adults. Dunks are best used from April – September, when mosquitoes are active.

Harnett county residents can pick up a four month supply of the insecticide at the Health Department which is located at 307 W. Cornelius Harnett Blvd., in Lillington between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30p.m. in the Environmental Health Division, while supplies last.





#### COMMUNITY HEALTH ASSESSMENT

This survey is being conducted to learn more about the health and quality of life in Harnett County and the results of the survey will be used to help address the major health and community issues in our county. #### FREE AT-HOME TEST KITS



Every home in the U.S. is eligible to order 4 free at-home COVID-19 tests. The tests are completely free. Orders will usually ship in 7-12 days. The tests available for order are rapid antigen at-home tests and can be taken anywhere. You will receive results within 30 minutes (no lab drop-off required). Order your tests at <u>www.covidtests.gov</u>. The first person to take a selfie and email it to tmckenrick@harnett.org will receive a prize.

#### **VACCINE & BOOSTER SHOTS**



The Health Department is providing the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine for ages 5 and older. The COVID-19 vaccines are free of charge to all individuals, regardless of immigration or health insurance status. If you would like to make an appointment, complete the <u>COVID-19 Vaccine Inquiry Form</u> or call the Health Department at 910-814-6582. All vaccinations will be administered by appointment. The Health Department is located within the Governmental Complex at 307 W. Cornelius Harnett Blvd in Lillington.

**Needing your booster shot?** Anyone ages 12 and older should receive a COVID-19 booster. Adults may receive any brand of the COVID-19 vaccine for their booster, while children 12 to 17 can only receive Pfizer. NCDHHS encourages individuals to speak with a doctor, nurse or pharmacist if they have questions about what booster is right for them. People who received a 3 dose mRNA COVID-19 vaccination series should receive their booster dose 3 months after the primary series. People who initiated vaccination with Johnson & Johnson's Janssen COVID-19 vaccine should receive a total of 3 doses now: 1 Johnson & Johnson's Janssen dose, followed by 1 additional mRNA dose at least 28 days later, then 1 booster dose at least 2 months after the 2nd (additional) dose. mRNA vaccines are preferred for the booster. Getting vaccinated is safe, easy, and free. To make an appointment call our office at 910-814-6582 or complete the <u>COVID-19 Vaccine Inquiry</u>.



Not only do they taste delicious, they offer nutritional benefits for you and your family.

# STRAWBERRY-SHALLOT SALSA <u>Ingredients</u>

- 2 tablespoons minced shallot •
- 2 tablespoons fresh lime juice
- 2 teaspoons honey •
- 1 teaspoon olive oil
- 1/2 teaspoon red wine vinegar •
- 1/2 teaspoon ground coriander
- 1/4 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1 tablespoon chopped fresh mint
- 11/2 cups finely chopped strawberries

## How to Make It

Combine minced shallot, fresh lime juice, honey, olive oil, and red wine vinegar in a medium bowl. Let stand 10 minutes. Stir in ground coriander, kosher salt, and chopped fresh mint. Add finely chopped strawberries; gently toss to combine.
