HARNETT COUNTY ANNOUNCED THE LAUNCH OF THE HARNETT COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PARTNERSHIP, A PUBLIC-PRIVATE ORGANIZATION PROMOTING LIVING WAGE JOBS AND CAPITAL INVESTMENT WITHIN THE COUNTY AND ITS MUNICIPALITIES.

This collaboration brings together elected officials, business leaders, and educational stakeholders to strengthen talent attraction, workforce development efforts, product development, and other initiatives that will lead to the expansion and attraction of companies.

The new Board of Directors consists of Phyllis Godwin (Godwin Group) as the Chair, Jeff Whittington (First Federal Bank) as Vice-Chair, Jake Mays (Boon Edam) as Treasurer, Scott Nelson (Gould and Goodrich), and Harnett County Commissioners Lewis Weatherspoon and Brooks Matthews.

Additional business leaders will be elected following a capital campaign with Convergent Nonprofit Solutions. In addition, educational leaders from Campbell University, Central Carolina Community College, and Harnett County Schools will join as ex-officio members in the coming months.

Morrow brings over three decades of experience and leadership in Government Administration, having served as a Land Survey Aide with Palm Beach County, Florida and an Operations Engineer with the Florida Department of Transportation.



As the newest Assistant County Manager, Morrow will oversee the County's Board of Elections, Emergency Services, Information Technology, Public Library, Veteran's Services, Fleet, and Facilities departments. He will also be tasked with collaborating with the UNC School of Government to manage the County's Performance Management project and serve on the Space Needs Study committee to provide input on future facility needs for County operations.

Morrow holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Public Management from Florida Atlantic University and a Master's of Science degree in Organization Leadership and Management from Palm Beach Atlantic University.


OPERATION GREEN LIGHT

N.C. SCHOOL BUS STOP LAW


All drivers must not only be aware around school buses, but also know the law of the road.

Instead, if you would like to receive weather Watch and Warning alerts via email and/or text message, we encourage you to sign up for our RAVE Public Notification System!

In the event potential disaster weather is forecasted (such as a hurricane), we will continue to push National Weather Service emails containing area forecasts starting three days out from the anticipated event.

STAY HEALTHY: GET YOUR FLU SHOT!

The best way to reduce your risk from seasonal flu and its potentially serious complications is to get vaccinated every year. Get your flu shot without leaving your car! The Health Department is providing "drive up" flu shots, Monday-Friday: 8:00-11:00am and 1:00-4:00pm at 307 W. Cornelius Harnett Blvd in Lillington. Influenza (flu) is a contagious respiratory illness caused by influenza viruses. It can cause mild to severe illness. Everyone 6 months and older should get a flu vaccine every season. Make plans to get vaccinated early in fall, before flu season begins. September and October are good times to get a flu vaccine.



FREE AT-HOME TEST KITS



The Health Department is providing free at-home COVID-19 test kits. Persons can pick up at-home COVID-19 test kits Monday-Friday between the hours of 8:00am-11:00am or 1:00pm-4:00pm at the Health Department which is located within the Governmental Complex at 307 W. VACCINE & BOOSTER SHOTS




CDC recommends COVID-19 vaccines for everyone <u>6 months and older</u>. The benefit of COVID-19 vaccines, like other vaccines, is that those vaccinated get protection without risking the potentially serious consequences of getting sick with COVID-19. Needing your booster shot? Staying up to date with your COVID-19 vaccines will provide you with the best protection against the COVID-19 virus. Anyone ages 5 and older should receive a single COVID-19 booster. Certain individuals may receive two COVID-19 boosters. NCDHHS encourages individuals to speak with a doctor, nurse or pharmacist if they have questions about what booster is right for them. Timing of your first booster is dependent on your primary series and your medical history. 






INGREDIENTS

- 2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 1/2 cups granulated sugar 1/2 cup butter, softened
- 1 cup pure pumpkin
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup powdered sugar

EASY PUMPKIN COOKIE RECIPE



INSTRUCTIONS

- Line baking sheets with parchment paper or spray with nonstick baking spray.
- Combine flour, baking soda, baking powder, cinnamon, nutmeg, and salt in a medium bowl.
- Beat granulated sugar and butter with mixer on medium high speed, then blend in pumpkin, egg, and vanilla until incorporated.
- Gradually mix in flour and dry ingredients. Refrigerate dough for 3-4 hours.
- Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Scoop dough into one inch balls. Roll in powder sugar, place dough balls on baking sheet (12 per sheet) and bake for 11–13 minutes.
- Remove from baking sheet to a cooling rack. When completely cool, store cookies in an airtight container.
